Whereas, These has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Montgomery, Alabama, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress approved 20th day of May, 1862, "Tp secure Homesteads to actual settlers on the Public Domain" and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Jane Nicholas, has been established and duly consumated, in conformity to law for the

Northwest quarter of northwest quarter of Section six in Township twenty one South of Range four west of Huntsville Meridian in Alabama, containing forty acres and seven hundredths of an acre according to the official plat of the survey of the said Land, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General:

Now Know Ye, that there is, therefore, granted by the United States unto the said Jane Nicholas the tract of land above described: To Have and To Hold the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Jane Nicholas, and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I Grover Cleveland, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

GIVEN under my hand, at the City of Washington, the fourth day of February, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eighty eight and of the Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and twelfth.
