THAT for and in consideration of four hundred and twenty-five and no/100 DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor to us paid in hand

do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Melvin Wilder,

the following described real estate, to-wit: The North half of the Southeast quarter ( $\frac{N}{2}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) and all that part of the southwest quarter of southeast quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) lying North and East of a line beginning at the north west corner of said  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  and running to the southeast corner of said last described forty acres, of land, all in Section 25 (twenty-five) Township (Nineteen) 19, Range One (1) West, and containing one hundred (100) acres more or less also Three (3) acres in the Northwest corner of the southeast quarter of southwest quarter of Section 25, Township 19, Range 1 West, described as follows: beginning at the northwest corner of said  $SE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$  and running south to the branch, thence down said branch to a line made by W.A.
