To All To Whom These Presents Shall Come, Greeting:

WHEREAS Matilda Calleyway of Shelby County Alabama

has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Matilda Callaway according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands", for The Southwest quarter, of the Northwest quarter, and the Northwest quarter of the southwest quarter, of Section Thirty-two, in Township 20, of Range two West, in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama, containing seventy nine acres and twenty two and a half hundredths of an acre.

according to the official plat of the Survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tracts have been purchased by the said Matilda Callaway

Now Know Ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the severals acts in such case made and provided, Have Given and Granted, and by these presents do give and grant, unto the said Matilda Callaway and to her heirs, the said tracts above described: To Have and To Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Matilda Callaway and to her heirs and assigns forever.

In Testimony Whereof, I James Buchanan President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
