TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, Thadius Duyck of Shelby County, Alabama, has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Thadius Duyck according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

the North West quarter of the North West quarter of Section one, in Township Nineteen of Range One East in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama containing forty acres and twelve and a half hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office of the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Thadius Duyck.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Thadius Duyck and to his heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Thadius Duyck and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I Millard Fillmore, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
