## Affidavit

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared Mrs. Eula Taylor Carter, who being first duly sworn deposes and says that she resides at Columbiana Alabama; that she is one of the grantors in that deed from Eula Taylor Carter and others to R. Frank Lyon dated December 4, 1940, conveying the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the North Half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter, and the southeast quarter of the Northeast quarter of Section 4, Township 21, Range 1 East, and the West half of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 3, Township 21, Range 1 East, containing 120 acres, and situated in Shelby County Alabama.

Affiant further saus that G. W. Taylor was her father, and that Adeline Taylor was her mother, and that her father died during the year 1904 intestate, and that there has never been any administration on his estate; and that said estate does not owe any debts; affiant further says that her mother, Adeline Taylor died on the 26th day of December, 1924.

Taylor, during said period have been, respectively, in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceful and adverse possession of said lands, claiming them as their own, respectively, against the world, and exercising acts of ownership over said property, and that the title of said heirs at law of said G. W. Taylor have never been questioned in anyway.
