I am acquainted with lots 4 and 5 in Block 10, according to the map of Arkwright, Alabama, and have known said land all of my life. In fact, I was born and reared in Arkwright. Cecil Bell was first living in the house on this property as far back as I can remember, which is about eighteen or twenty years ago, and he rented from my grand father, T. W. Carr, who was the surviving husband of Mrs. S. F. Carr. My grand father, T. W. Carr, died about 1926 as well as I can remember the date. His first wife, Mrs. S. F. Carr died many years prior to that time. During 1928 the sole surviving heirs at law of Mrs. S. F. Carr, the first wife of my grand-father I. W. Carr, deceased, were her three children, viz:

A. P. Carr, J. A. Carr and Matha L. Vincent.

I am a son of A. P. Carr, Mr. T. W. Carr, my grand-father, rented this property out and had tenants on it continuously until the time he died and after that the S. F. Carr heirs, rented it out continuously or some of them lived upon it until they deeded it to Martha L. Vincent, in 1928. After my father and my uncle, J. A Carr deeded the property to Martha L. Vincent, their sister, my father continued to live on the property, renting it from his sister, Martha L. Vincent, until she sold the property to L. L. Harris, and Julia V. Harris. B my personal knowledge, therefore, the property has been actually occupied by tenants of the S. F. Farr heirs or by some of the Carr heirs themselves, or by tenants of Mrs. Martha L. Vincent, or her grantees, L. L. Harris and Julia V. Harris, or by P. D. Warlikk and Irene Warlick, their tenants, continuously for the last eighteen or twenty years. During the time that I have known said lots S. M. Cast, was never in possession of any portion thereof.
