WHEREAS, James Williamson of Shelby County, Alabama has deposited in the General Land Office of the United Dtates a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said James Williamson according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "And act making further provision for the sale of the "ublic Lands," for the north east quarter of the northwest quarter of Section twenty three, in township nineteen of range two east in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama containing thirty nine acres and ninety eight and three quarters of an hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said James Williamson.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Cohgress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said James Williamson and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunites and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said James Williamson and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Andrew Jackson PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
