Henry M. Davis, known as H.M.Davis, whose wife was Caroline T.Davis, was my grand-father, and he died something like fifty years ago, - the exact date I do not know. His widow, Caroline T.Davis, died after he did and something like over thirty years ago. Said H.M.Davis left surviving him, besides his widow, the following children:

- 1.T.H.Davis,
- 2. Sarah E. Warlick, and
- 3. Carrie N. Davis.

Said T.H.Davis, my father, died in 1920 and left surviving him his widow, Edna V. Davis, who died intestate in 1933, and the following children, who constituted his sole heirs at law and next of kin entitled to share in the distribution of his estate, xiz:

- 1. Mary Davis Chancellor, whose husband is Walter Chancellor, Shelby County, Alabama.
- 2. Odessa Davis Wilder, whose husband/ B.L. Wilder, Gainsville Florida
- 3. J. T. Davis, who dies unmarried amd intestate in 1924.
- 4. E.B.Davis, also known as Embry B.Davis, who is single, Sylacauga Alabama,
- 5. Bernett Davis, a single man, who resides in Birmingham Alabama,
- 6. Vira Elizabeth Davis Reeder, whose husband is O.L.Reeder, New Hope, Madison County, Alabama.
- 7. Linda Caroline Davis Farr, whose husband/J.T.Farr, and who residesat 7708 6th Avenue, North, Birmingham Alabama.
- 8. William Pope Davis, who is a single man, and resides at Camp Blanding ,Florida, Anti Tank Company 167 Inf. 31st Division, A.P.O. 31.

My mother, Edba V. Davis, as stated, died intestate in 1933, and left surviving her as her sole heirs at law and next of kin ,all of the children or heirs of said T.H.Davis, except, J.T.Davis, her son, who died prior to her death, as hereinabove stated.

My father, T.H.Davis, was in possession of the hereinafter described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, from March, 1916, until the time of his death viz:

The west half of the northeast quarter and the east half of the northwest quarter of Dection 21, Township 19, Range 2 East, except that portion of the south east quarter of the northwest quarter lying west and south of the Harpersville-Sterrett public road, nowowned by W.W. Denty, who acquired title thereto from L. C. Bilbrey, to whom H.M.Davis deeded it on December the 6th, 1885, as shown by deed recorded in the Probate office of Shelby County, Ala, in deed book 26 at page 151.

and cultivated portions of it each and every year, or had it cultivated by tenants each and every year, and as a matter of fact reared his family there, and during said period of time no other person, firm or corporation was in possessession of any portion of said land and my father's possession thereof during said period of time was open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, actual and adverse.

After the death of my father, my mother continued to live on said land until about two years b efore her death, which, as stated, occurred in 1986, and during all of that time this land was in possession of the T.H.Davis heirs, and my mother, who either lived upon it and cultivated portions of it each and every year, or had it rented out, and in possession of tenants, who lived upon it and cultivated it.

After my mother's death the land remained in the possession of her heirs and the heirs of my father continuously until I obtained deeds from two of my sisters and one of my brothers, late in 1940 and during all that time we had it rented out to tenants who lived upon the land and cultivated portions of it each and every year.

I now own a four sevenths undivided interest in said land, having amouired a one seventh interest by inheritance from my father and mother and deceased brother, J.T. Davis, and having acquired a one seventh undivided interest from each of my brother, William Pope Davis, from my sister, Linda Caroline Farr and my sister, Vira Elizabeth Reeder.

About 115 acres or 120 acres of this land is in cultivation and the grater portion of that acreage has been in cultivation as far back as I cam remember and I was born on the land in
