Before me Grace Carter, a Notary Public in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared W.W.Denty, who is known to me, and who, being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I am sixty nine years of age, I am acquainted with the following land situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

The west half of the northeast quarter and the east half of the northwest quarter of Section 21 Township 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County, Alabama

I own that portion of the above described land lying south and west of the Harpersville and Sterrett road, which I acquired from L. C. Bildrey. I have known the 160 acres of land in question for more than fifty years and during that time I have lived in the same community where the land is situated.

When I first knew the land T.H.Davis, Sarah E Warlick and Carrie N.Davis, were in possession of the land, claiming to own the same, and they were the sole heirs at law and next of kin of Henry M. Davis.

I have read the foregoing affidavit of E. B. Davis and the facts stated therein are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief and I believe all of said facts to be true.

I know that T.H.Davis was in possession of all of this land north of the Harpersville-Sterrett public road from March, 1916, until the time of his death, and during that time he lived upon it and cultivated portions of it each and every year, or had it done, and as a matter of fact, he reared his family on this land.

Sarah E. Warlick, about 15 years ago, died and left surviving her, her husband, A.J. Warlick, who resides at Vincent, Shelby County, Alabama, and she never had any children.

Carrie N. Davis was never married, but had two children, viz: L.M. Davis and Ruth E. Campbell. Said Carrie N. Davis died in 1916, and her children, L.M. Davis and Ruth E. Campbell, who were her sole heirs at law, executed a deed to T.H. Davis conveying a portion of this land, as shown by deed recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 73 at page 47.
