KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, C. A. Glaze, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred fifty and 00/100--dollars, to me in hand paid by T. J. Martin, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, I do grant, bargain, sell and convey and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said T. J. Martin his heirs and assigns the following described real estate & all appurtenances thereunto belonging to-wit:

$W\frac{1}{2}$ of the $NW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, Township 19 Range 2 East.

$E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ Section 34, Township 19, Range 2 East-also fraction formerly owned by Mrs M.G.Kidd, commence at the line between M.G.Kidd & R.L. Flippen running south 150 yds west 70 yds, thence North to R.L.Flippen line containing 2 acres more or less-Also commencing at the corner near the ~~Hannah~~ ^{Hannah} house and thence north 140 yds thence down the section line west 70 yds, thence south 140 yds to Glaze corner, thence back to the beginning 2 acres more or less.

To have and to hold to the said T. J. Martin, his heirs and assigns forever.
