

DEED Wheeler Posey to Bennett Davis

STATE OF ALABAMA

This Indenture, made and entered into this nineteenth day of March in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and Thirty six between Wheeler Posey of the County of Shelby and State of Alabama of the first part and Bennett Davis of the County and State aforesaid of the second part witnesseth That I Wheeler Posey for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred dollars to me in hand paid thereceipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge before the sealing and delivery hath granted, bargained, sold and delivered and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Bennett Davis a certain Trect or parcel of land containing eighty acres and Thirteen Hundredths of an acre, Viz:

Being the East half of the North West quarter of Section Twenty one in Township Nineteen in Range two East in the District of Tuscaloosa and State of Alabama

to have and to hold the said land and the premises hereby conveyed with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Bennett Davis his heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns and be free from me, my heirs, Executors, Administrators and assigns and be free from the Claim of the United States and from the Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons claiming from by or through or under the same whether in Law or Equity.
