

## Affidavit #1547

Before me, the undersigned authority, personally appeared W.L. Christian, who being duly sworn, deposes and says that he resides at Columbiana Alabama; that J.P. Christian was his father, and L.E. Christian was his brother; and that affiant was one of the joint owners in the property sold under a petition of L E Christian filed September 6th, 1905, in the Probate Court of Shelby County, Alabama, petitioning sale for division of the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 32, Township 21, Range 1 East, and other lands; and that said lands were sold to L.E. Christian by the commissioner appointed by the court, as shown by the records in the probate office of Shelby County, Alabama. Affiant further says that upon confirmation of said sale the said L.E. Christian went into possession of said property and soon thereafter conveyed the same to W.W. Lewis, as shown by deed of record. Affiant further says that he received his share in the proceeds derived from said sale; and that he knows that all the other heirs at law of the said J.P. Christian received their pro rata share; and that the heirs at law of said J.P. Christian claim no right nor interest in said land.

Affiant further says that the above described lands is no part of the lands conveyed by L. E. Christian to George W Templin in the year 1906.
