The above described land is approximately 3/4 of a mile south of Calera, Alabama and lies in the SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of the NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 2, Township 24 N, Range 13 E.

For and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction or improvement of said land, we hereby release the State Highway Department of the State of Alabama and all its employees and officers from all consequential damages, present or prospective, to our property, arising out of the construction, improvement, maintenance or repair of said highway, It is further agreed that all of the employees and officers of the State Highway Department of the State of Alabama shall have ingress and egress at any and all times to the property covered by this easement, for the purpose of:

Obtaining borrow excavation

without hirdrance or delay of any kind. That the construction or improvement of the aforesaid highway is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
