KNOW AIL MEN BY THE SE PRESENTS: That I, Mary Alice Boyd, a resident citizen of Elba, Coffee County, Alabama, being over the age of twenty one years, and being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and publish this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills which may have been made at any time heretofore by me.

First: I will that all of my just debts and funeral expenses, including a simple and appropriate slab or stone for my grave, shall be paid by my executors as soon after my decease as practicable.

Second: I give and bequeath unto my sister, Mrs.Lina Boyd Mizell, or the heirs of her body, the sum of \$1,000.00.

Third: I give and bequeath to my neice, Caroline Carmichael the sum of \$1,000.00. Should my said neice predecease me, then I give and bequeath the said \$1,000.00 to my sister, Sallie Boyd Carmichael, or the heirs of her body.

Fourth: I give and bequeath to my neice, Jane Boyd, the sum of \$1,000.00 Should she predecease me, then I give and bequeath the said \$1,000.00 to my brother Ja. P. Boyd, or the heirs of his body,

Fifth: I give and bequeath to the children of my deceased sister Mrs. Warre Boyd McKinnon, jointly amd in equal shares, my diamond ring of the approximate value of \$500.00, having alread; advanced, expended or paid out more than \$500.00 for the benefit of the Children of my said deceased sister since their mother's death.

Sixth: I give, devise and bequeath and undivided one fourth interest in end to all the rest remainder and residue of my estate am effects, real, personal or mixed, to my sister, Lina Boyd Mizell, or the heirs of her body; an undivided one fourth interest thereof to my sister, Mrs. Sallie Boyd Carmichael, or the heirs of her body; an undivided one fourth interest thereof to my brother Ja.P.Boyd, or the heirs of his body; and, an undivided one fourth interest thereof to the children of my deceased sister, Mrs. Warre Boyd McKinnon, viz: Sarah Boyd Dennis, Edna McKinnons, Alice McKinnon, and Frances McKinnon.

Seventh: Be it remembered, however, that I am not at all forgetful or unappreciative of my dearly beloved mother, Mrs. Sally Boyd, but am making no provision for her in this will, for in the natural course of events she will predecease me, and because my mother is now otherwise provided for, None the less, and in the event I should predecease my mother, I commend her to the faithful care and love of my brother and sisters.

Eight: I nominate and appoint Ja.P.Boyd, Sallie Boyd Carmichael and Lina Boyd Mizell as the executors of this my last will and tesmanent, and I declare that they shall not be required to give bond for the performance of their duties arising hereunder, nor shall they be required to make any inventory of the property collected by them as such executors, and they are further hereby exempted from making any report or final settlement of their doings hereunder to any court having jurisdiction of the administration of my estate. Should either of the executors named predecease me or die before the termination of their duties hereunder, the remaining executors or executor, as the case may be, shall have full authority and right to administer or complete the administration of this will and my estate.

Ninth: I authorize and empower my executors or the survivors of the survivor of them, if and whenever, in the settlement of my estate, they deem it advisable, at their or his discretion, to sell thewhole or any part of my real and personal property, at public or private sale,

and to execute and deliver all deeds, instruments of transfer, and other writings necessary to pass a proper title thereto. I further authorize and empower my said executors to do any and all things necessary for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of this will. And I direct them to administer my estate so as to carry outthe provisions of this will in as expeditious a manner as practicable.
