## Transmission Line Bermit

We, George Huddleston and wife, Bertha Huddleston for and in consideration of the sum of One & No/100---- Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama;

East half of southeast quarter of northeast quarter, Section 30; and the north half of northwest quarter, Section 29; all in Township 19, Range 1 East. The southwest quarter of northeast quarter of northwest quarter of southeast quarter, section 5; all of Section 8, except southeast quarter of southeast quarter; all in Township 19, Range 1 West.

All poles are to be set within 2 feet of the Highway right of way.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines;
and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions,
that may injure or endanger said lines.

nTO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
