Begin at a point in NW1 of NE1 Section 30, tp. 19, Range 1 East which point is on the South side of the Florida Short Route R/W directly South from and opposite to the point marked by R/W stone PT 852-156; run thence South parallel with North-South center line of said section 30 to the East-West center line of said section 30, thence West along said center line 660 ft, thence North parallel with the North - South center line of said section 30 to the South boundary line of said Highway R/W; thence Southeasterly along said R/W to point of beginning containing 22 acres more or less in the W2 of NE1 of section 30, tp. 19, R 1 East.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
