DEGREE RELIEVING MINOR OF DISABILITIES OF NON AGE

This cause coming on to be heard at this time, and having been submitted for decree on the petition and Ex-Parte affidavits of Myrtle I. Elliott and J. L. Sharbutt, and the court being of the opinion that it is, and will be, to the interest of the said minor to be relieved of the disabilities of non-age and upon consideration thereof.

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED BY this court that Gloria Myrtle Brasher, a minor who is over the age of eighteen years, be, and she is hereby relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and she is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract, and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which she is entitled; to purchase real or personal, to sell and convey any of said property, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if she were twenty-one years of age.

It is further ordered and decreed that the petitioner pay the cost of these proceedings.
