Black for and consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ less that part of owned by Mrs. M. A. Wyatt also 5 acres more or less in the or less in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying East of Spring Creek also 2 acres more or less in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ being in the Southeast corner of said 40 also west part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ lying west and south of Longview road all in Sec 36, Tp 21 R 3 W.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
