TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENT SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Assistant Commissioner is on file in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homestead, to Actual Settler on the Public Domain, " and the acts supplemental thereto, the claims of Ester Oland Fraser has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter of Section ten in Township twenty-two, south of the Range one east of the Huntsville Meridian, Alabama; containing forty acres, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the General Land Office;

NOW KNOWN YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the United State unto the said Claimant the tract of land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract of land, with the appurtenances thereof unto the said claimant and to the heirs and assigns of the said claimant forever.
