LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF ALEX HUNDLEY, COLORED, OF CALERA, SHELBY COUNTY, ALABAMA.  
IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN.

I, Alex Hundley, of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make and declare this to be my last will and testament, revoking any and all other wills heretofore made by me at any time.

FIRST.

I give, devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter Tisher Dixon of Calera, Shelby County, Alabama, who has at all times been a kind and affectionae daughter to me, and who during the past fourteen years has been of great assistance to me in caring for me and looking after my comfort and well being, all of my property, real, personal and mixed, of which I shall die seized and possessed, or to which I shall be entitled to at my decease, to have and to hold the same to her, the said Tisher Dixon, her heirs and assigns forever.

SECOND.

I nominate and appoint my said daughter, Tisher Dixon, to be sole executrix of my estate, and direct that she be exempted from giving an official bond for the proper discharge of her duties as such executrix.
