Bailey and to his heirs, the said tracts above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said John A. Bailey

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
