Alabama:

Commencing at an iron stake 435 ft SW from Ray's lot on the West marginal line of Vincent,

And Pell City Highway, thence Sw along said highway 210 ft, thence West 210 ft, thence NE

210 ft to a stake 432 ft from SW corner of Ray's lot thence East 210 ft to starting point,

containing one acre, more or less, and being aparttof SW2 of SE2 of Section 2 T 19 R 2 East.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injureor endanger said lines.
