3 acre lot \( \frac{1}{4} \) mile of Vincent, Ala., in NE\( \frac{1}{4} \) of section 11 t 19 R 2 E, de cribed as follows:

Commence at point where Glover's Ferry road crosses East boundary line of said NEt of NWt of section 11 Thence north 140 yards, then ce west 140 yards, thence south 140 yards, to road, thence along road to beginning.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof inclu ding the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TOCHOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
