Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority, G. W. Farris, known to me, who being by me first duly sworn, says on his oath as follows:

My name is G. W. Farris. I live in Jefferson County, Alabama, and have resided in said county for more than twenty-five years. I am 66 years of age and have spent my entire time as a realty agent, representing buyers and sellers of real estate in Jefferson, Shelby and many other counties in Alabama.

I am familiar with the lands situated in the north half of the southeast quarter of section two, township 20 range 2 west in Shelby County, Alabama, as well as those in the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter in section one, township 20 range 2 west in Shelby County, Alabama, as I have acted as agent for buyers and sellers of lands situated in and around said two sections for many years. I know of my own knowledge that no oil or gas wells were ever sunk on either of said two aforementioned parts of said sections one and two prior to September 9th, 1931, nor subsequent thereto, nor was any gas or oil well or wells commenced to be drilled on either of said portions of said sections at any time since September 8th, 1921, down to the present day. All leases for oil and gas or either of them on both of said tracts were abandoned.
