do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Annie Nelson

the following described real estate, to-wit: a part of lot number sixteen (16) in the town of Montevallo according to the original plan of said town as recorded in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama; the said part hereby conveyed being particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on the southeast margin of Valley Street which is seventy-five feet southwest of the southernmost intersection of Valley and Shelby Streets, according to said plan and which point is the northernmost corner of said lot numbersixteen (16) running thence southwest along the margin of said Valley Street, a distance of fifty (50) feet; thence southeast, perpendicular to said Valley Street, a distance of ninety (90) feet; thence northeast, parallel with said Valley Street, fifty (50) feet, to the line between lots sixteen (16) and seventeen (17) and thence northwest, along said division line, ninety (90) feet to the point of beginning, situated in Shelby County, Alabama.
