## SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

THIS SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT made this 18th day of September, 1941 by and between R. C. Williams of U. S. Hgwy 31, Clanton, Alabama hereinafter called "Lessor", and SHELL OIL COMPANY, INCORPORATED, a Virginia Corporation having a usual place of business at 400 William Oliver Bldg., in the city of Atlanta, County of Fulton, State of Georgia, hereinafter called "Lessee."
