It is provided that all pipe lines constructed under this grant shall be confined to a strip of ground thirty feet in width, the center line of which shall be the center line of the first pipe line hereafter installed by Grantee over, upon, through, under or across said lands.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said easements unto the PLANTATION PIPE LINE COMPANY, its successors and assigns, so long as a pipe line is maintained thereon.

The undersigned Grantors, their successors, heirs or assigns, reserve the right to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except as the same may be necessary for the purposes herein granted.

The undersigned covenant to and with Grantee, successors and assigns, that the undersigned are the owners of the above described lands and have the right, title and capacity to convey the right-of-way and easement hereby granted.

The Grantee, by the acceptance hereof, agrees to bury the pipe lines so that they sill not interfere with the cultivation of the land, and also to pay any damage to crops, fences and timber, which may arise from laying, maintaining, operating or removing such pipe lines. Said damages, if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons; one to be applinted by the undersigned, successors, helps or assigns; one by the Gratee, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two persons

aforesaid, and the award of such three persons, or any two of them, shall be final and conclusive.

It is understood and acknowledged by the undersigned that the person securing this grant is without authority to make any agreement in regard to the subject matter hereof which is not expressed herein, and that no such agreement will be binding on the Grantee.
