

TIMBER DEED

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, whereas the Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc., did heretofore by conveyance dated November 10, 1941, sell to Cleedy H. Fulton certain timber located in the following Sections: 32, 33 and 34, Township 20, Range 2 West, also Sections 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 9, Township 21, Range 2 West, all in Shelby County, Alabama, and under the provisions of said conveyance the said Fulton was granted the right to cut the timber thereby conveyed at any time up to January 1, 1944, and

WHEREAS, said conveyance covering that part of the timber located in Section 9, above described, conveyed to the said Fulton all of the timber of the size of 10" and above, measured 12" above the ground, and

WHEREAS, the said Fulton now desires to obtain from the Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc. an additional period of one year in which to cut and remove the timber conveyed by the above described deed and also desires to purchase the timber located in the above described part of Section 9 of the size of 8" and above, measured 12" above the ground, and the said Fulton has agreed to pay the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00) for this additional one year's time and the right to cut the 8" timber in said Section 9.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the payment by the said Cleedy H. Fulton to the undersigned Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc. of the sum of eight hundred dollars (\$800.00), receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc. does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey to the said Cleedy H. Fulton all of the timber of the size of 8" and above, measured 12" above the ground, located in that part of Section 9, Township 21, Range 2 West, Shelby County, owned by said Company and described in said conveyance of November 10, 1941, and the said Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc. does hereby grant unto the said Cleedy H. Fulton and additional one year's time in which to cut all of said timber heretofore conveyed, including the 8" timber in Section 9, it being understood that the said Cleedy H. Fulton will now have until January 1, 1945, in which to cut and remove said timber and any timber not cut and removed from the property on January 1, 1945, will revert to the Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Longview-Saginaw Lime Works, Inc. has caused this conveyance to be executed in its behalf by its President, Georgia A. Brewer, who is duly authorized, and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed and attested on this 23rd day of March, 1942.
