POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That Reconstruction Finance Corporation, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress, entitled "Reconstruction Finance Corporation Act", approved January 22, 1932, as amended, hereby and by these presents does make, constitute and appoint L. C. Walker, Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Columbiana, Alabama, its true and lawful attorney for it and in its name and stead to enter on the margin of the record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, a satisfaction in full of the following described mortgages and the indebtedness secured thereby:

Original mortgage executed by Montevallo Coal Mining Company, a corporation, Aldrich, Alabama, to Reconstruction Finance Corporation, under date of October 17, 1938, in the principal amount of TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$25,000.00), which mortgage

recorded in Mortgage Record 179, at pages 97-109, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, on December 21, 1938.

Supplemental mortgage executed by Montevallo Coal Mining Company, a corporation, Aldrich, Alabama, to Reconstruction Finance Corporation, under date of June 26, 1940, which mortgage was recorded in Mortgage Record 183, at page 479, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, on June 27, 1940.

Supplemental mortgage executed by Montevallo Coal Mining Company, a corporation, Aldrich, Alabama, to Reconstruction Finance Corporation, under date of April 18, 1941, which mortgage was recorded in Mortgage Record 186, at page 239, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, on April 19, 1941.

The foregoing giving and granting unto its said attorney, L. C. Walker, Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Columbiana, Alabama, full power and authority to do and to perform all and every act and thing requisite, necessary and proper to be done for the purpose of effecting the premises herein contained, and hereby ratifying and confirming all its said lawful attorney may do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

The foregoing power and authority of L. C. Walker is limited to the acts expressly set out herein.
