This indenture made and entered into this the 19th day of November, A. D. 1869 between W. L. Davis of one part and Margaret R. Davis of the other part.

Witnesseth, that the said W. L. Davis has given or conveyed the title of said lands to said Margaret R. Davis, being the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, Township 18 Range 2 East and SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12 Township 18 Range 2 East containing 80 acres more or less and all that pertain there unto. Which right I will warrant and defend to the said Margaret R. Davis her heirs executors and assigns to be free from me, my heirs and all other claims of every description, which I find myself, heirs and executors to warrant and defend the title as aforesaid against all claims whether in law or equity and against the Government of the United States.

In testamentary hereof I have set my hand and seal. This the 10th day of Nov. 1869.
