KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: THAT WHEREAS, on 8 day of May, A.D., 1939, the Probate Court of Shelby County, rendered a dedree for the sale of lands hereinafter described and conveyed, for the payment of State and County taxes then due from Russell F. Johnson the owner of said lands, and for the payment of the fees, costs, and expenses of and under said decree, and the sale had in execution thereof.

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, to-with on the 19thday of June, 1939, under and in pursuante of said decree, said lands were regularly offered for sale by the Tax Collector of Shelby County for said taxes, fees, costs, and expenses, and no person having bid a sufficient sum for said lands to pay the same, said lands were bid in for the State for the sum of said taxes, fees, costs, and expenses.

AND WHEREAS, the time allowed by law for the redemption of said lands has elapsed since said sale is still in the State.

NOW THEREFORE, The State Land Commissioner of the State of Alabama, by virtue of and in accordance with the authority in him vested by law, with the approval of the Governor of Alabama, and in consideration of the premises above set out, has bhis day granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sold, and conveyed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. T. Davis, without warranty or coverant of any kind on the part of the State, express of implied, all right and title of the State of Alabama, in and to said lands, described as follows:
