all in Township 21 Range 2 West

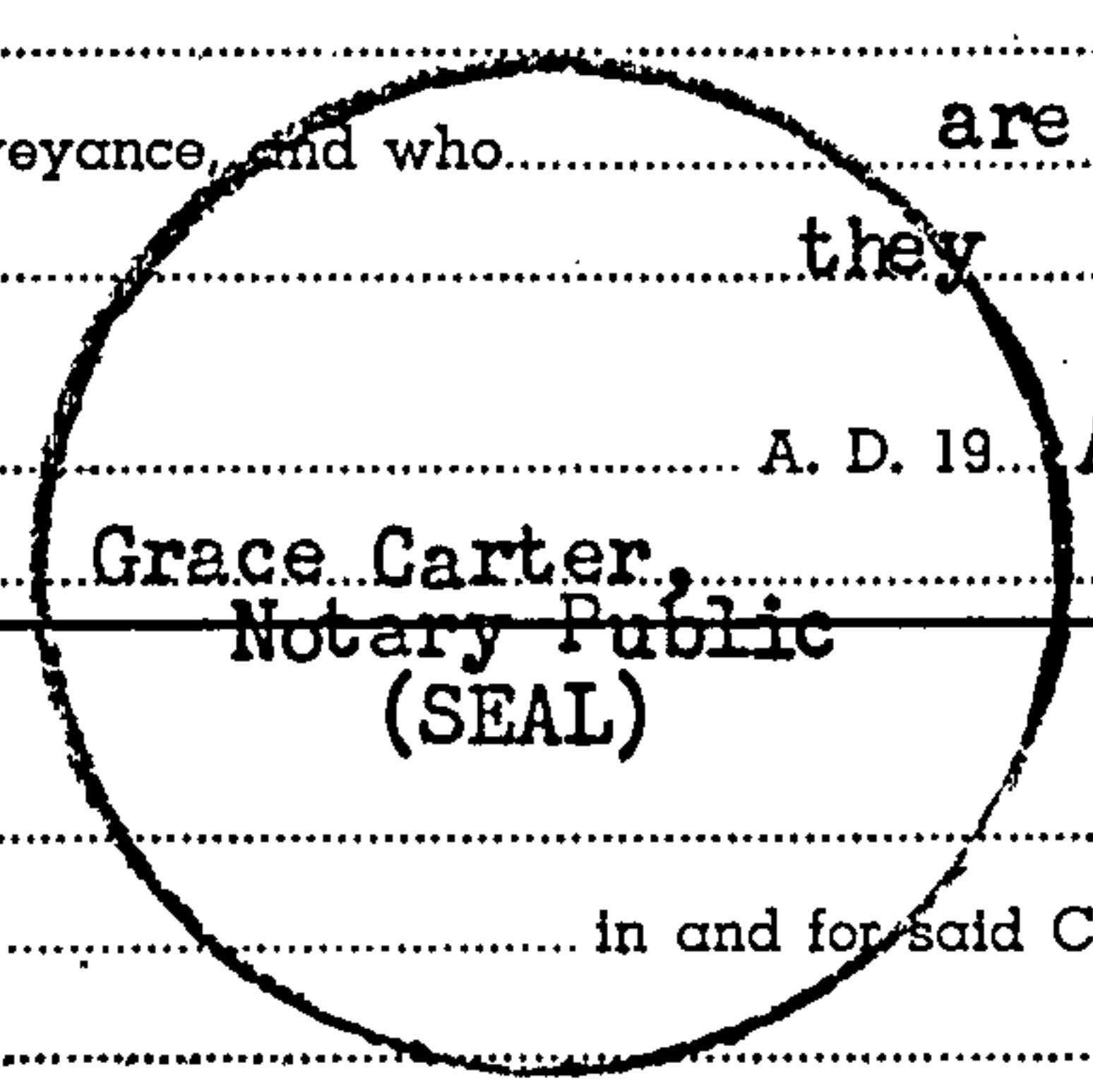

heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

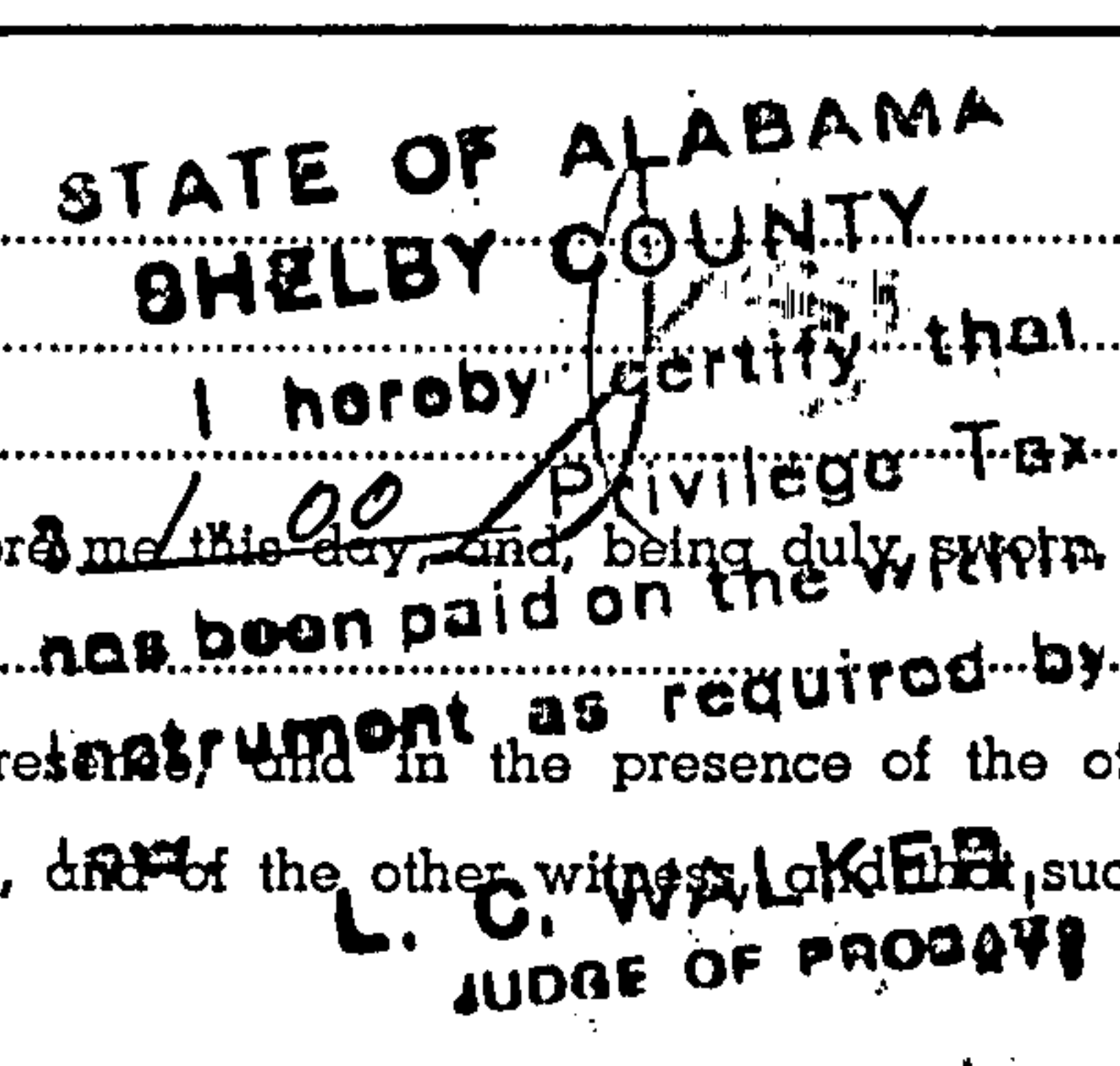

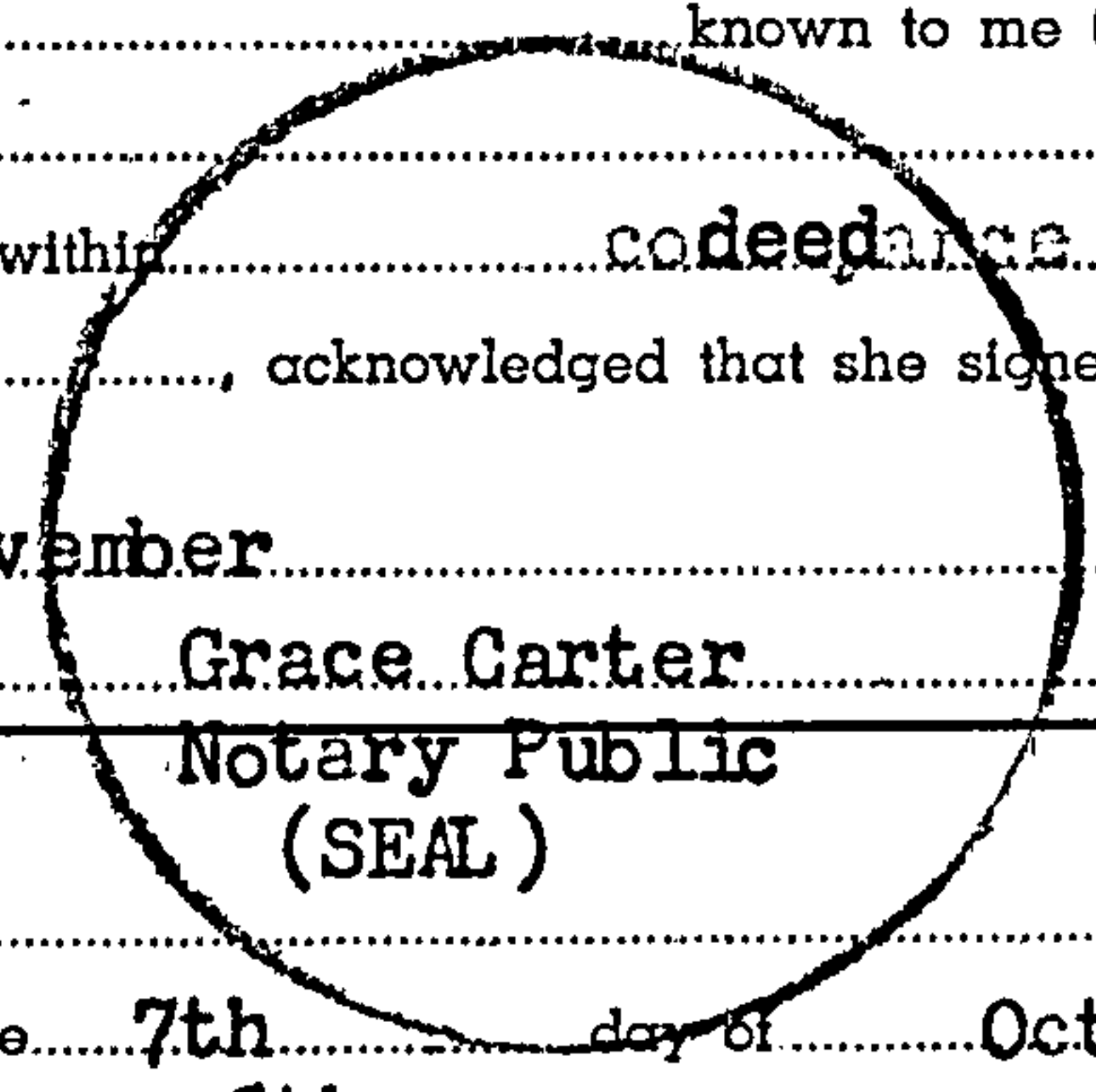
