Anstrip 25 feet wide, beginning at a point 300 feet East of the South-weat corner of the SE_{\pm}^1 of the NE_{\pm}^1 of Section 32, Township 17, Range 1 East, and run thence in a Northwesterly direction and parallel with the present right of way of the Alabama Power Company, a distance of 2 2000 feet, more or less, to the West line of the SW_{\pm}^1 of the NE_{\pm}^1 of said Section 32, being a strip 25 feet in width lying North-east and adjacent to the present right of way line across the S_{\pm}^1 of the NE_{\pm}^1 of Section 32, Township 17, Range 1 East.

Condition, however, should said strip of land be no longer used as a right of way, then said land and easement shall revert to the grantors or their heirs.
