Paul O. Luck and wife, Clarice W. Luck and Lena Brewer and husband, R. Brewer, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty and no/100 Dollars (\$50.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant, to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time, electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described land situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

A strip 25 feet wide, beginning at a point 300 feet East of the South-west corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 17, Range 1 East, and run thence in a Northwesterly direction and parallel with the present right of way of the Alabama Power Company, a distance of 2000 feet, more or less, to the West line of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 32, being a strip 25 feet in width lying North-east and adjacent to the present right of way line across the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 17, Range 1 East.

Condition, however, should said strip of land be no longer used as a right of way, then said land and easement shall revert to the grantors or their heirs.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut, and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.
