The NEt of SWE and the NWE of SEE of Sec. 35 Tp 18 Range 2 East

The Power Company agrees to pay all damages to crops on said lands caused by it during the construction or maintenances of said line provided, Notice of such damage is given the company within thrity (30) days after such damage accures, however, the grantors, their heirs or a ssigns shall have no lieu for the payment of such amounts.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
