## DECREE RELIEVING MINORS OF DISABILITIES OF NON-AGE

IN the Matter of the Petition of W. C. Walker, to relieve Earnest Walker of the disabilities of non-age.

This cause coming on to be heard at this term, and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex parte affidavits of W. I. Linderman and Flora Linderman, thereupon, upon consideration thereof it is ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that Earnest Walker, a minor, who is over the age of eighteen, be and he is relieved of the disabilities of non-age, and he is vested with the right to sue and be sued, contract, to buy, sell and convey real estate and generally to do and perform all acts which such ~~minor could~~ minor could lawfully do if he were twenty-one years of age, except None

And it is further decreed that the said Earnest Walker pay the costs of this proceeding, for which execution may issue.
