10 acres of land off the northeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27,

Township 21, Range 2 West. Said land being in a square shape.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above granted premiese unto the said Maggie Sawyers, her heirs and assigns, forever.
