I own the following described lands in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

23; and all of the East half of the Southeast Quarter of Section
25, which lies North of the Southern Railway right-of-way, all

I went into possession of said property immediately upon the execution of said deed and remained in the open, notorious, exclusive, continuous and adverse possession of the same down to the present time, and during all of said time I have lived upon said property and cultivated the same or had the same vultivated or have had tenants on it, cultivating portions of it each and every year and no other person, firm or corporation has been in possession of any of said premises during that time.

My attention is called to a mortgage executed by Fred H. Hardy and wife to H. A. Shepard, dated May 23, 1929 and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in Mortgage Book 158, at page 510, in which is conveyed all that part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 6, Township 24, Range 13 East, which lies North and East of the Southern Railway Right-of-way.

Mr. Hardy did own some land north of the railroad in said forty, but he did not own or has never been in possession of that forty described in my deed from the Comers.
