Elven S. Spates and wife Lillian Spates for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Five Dollars, (\$25.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, and a ppliance necessary or convenient in connection therewith from time to time upon, and counter-poise wires or other counter-poise conductors under, a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said strip is now located by the final location survey thereof heretofore made by said Company, over and across the land of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of said strip, together with all rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may hereafter injure or endanger any of the works of said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a part of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35 Township 19 South Range 2 East.

Said strip is approximately described as follows:

Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuations thereof: Commence at a point 2299.8 feet, more or less, West of Northeast Corner of said Section 35, where the East boundary of right of way of Alabama Power Company's Sylacauga-Leeds transmission line intersects the North boundary of said Section 35, run thence South 23 degrees 27 minutes East 1678.2 feet to point of beginning in said SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35. From said point of beginning, run North 79 degrees 53 minutes East 313.6 feet, more or less, to a point on East boundary of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns, forever.

The grantors shall have the right to cultivate and use said strip of land for any purpose not inconsistent with the rights which the grantee may from time to time exercise hereunder.
