Moore, for and in consideration of the sum of One & No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, the receipt whreof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maint ain electric transmission lines and all telegraph and telephone lines, towers, poles and appliances necessary or convenient in connection the rewith from time to time upon, and counter-poise wires or other count er-poiseconductors under, a strip of land one hundred feet in width, as said strip is now located by the location final/survey the reof heretofore made by said company over and across the lands of which it is hereinafter described as being a part, said survey to determine the boundaries of sai strip, together with all rights and pribileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof for the purposes above described, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said strip and the right to cut and keep clear all trees and undergrowth and other obstruction on said strip and danger trees adjacent thereto which now or may he reafter injure or endanger any of the works on said strip, and the right to install, maintain and use anchors and guy wires on land adjacent to said strip.

Said strip is a prt of a tract of land situated in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows

West half of northwest quarter of Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 3 East. Said strip is approximately described as follows:

Fifty feet on each side of a line and the continuations thereof: Commence at a point

2299.8 feet, more or less, west of northeast corner of Section 35, Township 19 South, Range 2 East, where the east boundary of right of way of Alabama Power Company's Sylacauga-Leeds transmission line intersects the north boundary of said Section 35, run thence south 23 degrees 27 minutes each 1678.2 feet to a point in southwest quarter of northeast quarter of said Section 35, run thence north 79 degrees 53 minutes east 2393.7 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe, which is an angle point. From said angle point run south 88 degrees 52 minutes east 4650.9 feet, more or less, to a point on west boundary of northwest quarter of northwest quarter of Section 31, Township 19 South, Range 2 East, which is the point of b ginning.
