My name is R. E. Bowden, Sr. I was President of Citizens' Bank, Calera, Alabama, from the year 1910 to the year 1915 and was familiar with the business transactions of said Bank. Said Bank has been out of business since 1916, and I know of my own personal knowledge that that certain mortgage from Mary Lee West and husband, P. O. West, to said Bank, dated February 28, 1911 for \$407.88 and recorded in Mortgage Book 88, Page 284, in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, has heretofore been paid in full; I also know that that certain mortgage from Mary Lee West and husband, P. O. West, to Citizens' Bank dated January 9, 1912 for \$650.00, which was recorded in Mortgage Book 98, Page 207 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and which was transferred to Julia A. Gunn, has heretofore been paid in full.
