

RIGHT OF WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

STATE OF ALABAMA
SHELBY COUNTY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, J.H. Stone and wife Ann S. Stone, of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of \$50.00 in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the lands of the undersigned in Shelby County, Ala., for a public road; Which right of way shall be 66 feet in width or 33 feet in width on each side of the center line of the said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department or as much of our lands as is required by make a 66 foot right of way, across our lands which are located and described/as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land 66 feet wide lying 33 feet on each side of the centerline beginning at station 928 plus 68 and running to station 932 plus 75 where said strip of land becomes 33 feet wide lying on the left of the centerline, thence run to station 937 plus 84 end of said strip of land.

As now staked out by the State Highway Dep't of Ala. SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of S 28. T 19 S. R2E. Also. 99Ac. and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
