I went into possession of said property described in said deed immediately upon the execution thereof and have had tenants living on said property, cultivating portions thereof each and every year down to the present time, and from the date of said deed to the present time, I have been in the open, notorious, continuous, exclusive and adverse possession of said property through tenants who live upon said property and cultivated the same each and every year down to the present time.
