DECREE RELIEVING MINORS OF DISABILITIES OF

NONAGE

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF WILLIE MAE FINLEY,

TO BE RELIEVED OF THE DISABILITIES OF NONAGE

This cause coming on to be heard in term time on this the 9 day of April, 1943, and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of Virgil C. Finley and Howard Finley, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that the said Willie Mae Finley a Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen years, be and she is Relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage, and she is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which she is entitled; to purchase Real or Personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if she were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Willie Mae Finley pay the costs of this proceeding, for which Execution may issue.
