and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of Dollars (\$ ) in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof of hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and cowey unto the said Shelby County, its successors or assiges, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the lands of the undersigned for a public road: Which right of way shall be feet in width on each side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked by the designated as our lands as is required to make a foot right of way across our lands which said right of way is described as follows:

A strip of land 15 feet wide extending North and South across the West side of the  $E_2^1$  of  $W_2^1$  of  $SW_4^1$  of Section 3, Township 21 Range 1 East

and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the County from all consequental damages, prestent or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is herby admitted and acknowledged.
