A strip of land 40 feet wide, beginning at a point on the right-of-way and main track of the Southern Railway at a point 1200 feet west of Mile Post 112-N, near Wilsonville, Alabama, and extending across said right of way and main track to the line dividing Grantor's land from the land of Will Stone

It is understood and agreed that in theevent said strip of land/ever be discontinued or abandoned for use as a right of way as herein contemplated, then the same shall revert to the Grantorherein without notice.
