Personally came and appeared before me Wm. D. McConaughy, a Notary Public in and for said County and said state Jake Boyle, who after being first by me duly sworn according to law to speak the truth deposeth and says:

I am 62 years of age and have lived in Shelby County, Alabama, all of my life. Iam a son of John Boyle who at the time of his death about 53 years ago owned and was in possession of the following described land, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter Section 5 Township 24 Range 13 East which lies South of the Old Calera and Montevallo Road.

About the year 1916 my brother John Boyle, my half brother, Henry Graham and I bought this land from the other heirs of my father. We went in to immediate possession and one or more of us lived on the land all the time and we had under fence or in cultivation all of said land each year claiming to own it. And we assessed it for taxes and paid the taxes each year. About September, 1925 Henry Graham and his wife sold to John Boyle and me Henry's interest in an acre which included the house. Soon thereafter about December 12, 1925, Henry Graham and wife, Elsie, John Boyle and wife, Lucille, my wife, Viola and I executed and delivered to Mr. R.E. Bowden a deed conveying the remainder of the above described land and placed him in possession thereof.

My father, John Boyles, died about 53 years ago. His children were Mary Boyles who married Agch Thomas, they are both dead and had only one child now about 51 years of age; Marth Boyle married Allan Sharpe, they are both dead, and are survived by one child now about 50 years of age; Misah Boyle married Mary Pelhem they had no children, he has been dead for more than 3 years; Walter Boyle married Mary Floyd, he has been dead for more than 3 years. They have 5 children somewhere in Ohio. I am not sure but to the best of my judgment they are all over 24 years of age; of their ages, Lucindia Boyle married Sam Brown, both are dead and are survived of one child now 49 years of age; Phebie Boyle married Ed Cunningham, now dead, she is 71 years of age; Mollie Boyle married Will Baker, both death, two children one is 45 and the other 48; Sallie Boyle married Jim Carlton, she is dead and survivingare two children, one 32 and the other 35; Jake Boyle the affiant and John heretofore mentioned in this affâdavit; Thad Boyle now 58; Fannie who married Lerory Bias is now 46; there were four other children who died in infancy.

None of the heirs of my father, Jake Boyle, except John and I have made any claim to or have been in possession of any part of the above described land since 1916 and all the time that Henry Graham and John Boyle and affiant were in possession of said land from 1916 to 1925, we claimed adverse to all the other heirs of my father Jake Boyle and our possession was exclusion, continuous, complete, peaceful, quiet, adverse, hostile and under claim of ownership by purchases from Said heirs.
