the north west quarter of the south west quarter, of section five, in township twenty-four, of range thirteen east in the District of Lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing thirty-nine acres, and ninety-five and a quarter hundredths of an acre,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said Thomas Arnett.

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity

with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said Thomas Arnett and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To Have and to Hold, the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said Thomas Arnett and to his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I, Andrew Jackson President of the United States of America, have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
