KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, Mrs. M. O. Carr and wife of the county and state aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid by Shelby County, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the further consideration of the benefits accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a right of way hereinafter described, over and across the lands of the undersigned in Shelby County, Ala., for a public road; Which right of way shell be 33 feet in width or 33 feet in width on left side of the center line of the said road, as it is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, or as much of our lands as is required to make a 33 foot right of way, across our lands which are located and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land 33 feet wide lying on the left of centerline beginning at station 1084 plus 48.6 and ending at station 1084 plus 88 as now staked out by the highway department.

and for and in consideration of the benefit to our porperty by reason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
