A strip of land 33 feet wide lying on the right of the centerline beginning at station 1048 plus 21 and ending at station 1058 plus 60.

and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by meason of the construction of said road, we hereby release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
